## **House of Delegates 2019**

The annual business meeting of NCSMA will be held on Friday, April 26, 2019 during the annual convention held in Burlington, NC. During this meeting representatives from the active component chapters will review reports from the committees and officers, vote for the incoming officers and elect delegates and alternates to represent NCSMA in the AAMA House of Delegates. The annual budget will also be presented for approval. Only duly elected chapter representatives are able to vote, but all members are welcome to attend. Speaker Stephanie Hodgin, CMA (AAMA) and Vice-Speaker Vicki Rummage, CMA (AAMA) have been busy gathering reports for the packet provided to delegates and alternates and verifying the credentials of the elected chapter representatives.

If you are a delegate or alternate your packet will be mailed to you in the coming weeks. The Speaker and Vice-Speaker remind all delegates and alternates that they **MUST** present their current AAMA membership card to the credentials desk, which opens at 8:00 am on Friday, prior to being seated in the house.

Chapter Presidents are asked to inform Speaker Hodgin (<a href="mailto:onegreatcma99@gmail.com">onegreatcma99@gmail.com</a>) and Vice-Speaker Rummage (<a href="mailto:cma">cma</a> nana5@yahoo.com</a>), as soon as possible, if there is a change in your delegates (i.e. an alternate needs to be substituted for a delegate). If a delegate is not able to be at the HOD and the chapter does not have available alternate(s) to take their place a PROXY card will be issued so the chapter will be allowed the number of votes to which they are entitled. Delegates and alternates that are to be seated in the house are reminded to be in their seats 15 minutes prior to the opening of the house at 8:30 am, so that the business of NCSMA can be conducted efficiently and effectively. ## It's Almost Convention Time!

The highlight of the NCSMA year – the convention is scheduled for April 25-28, 2019.
